BALDWIN V, Count of Hainaut and Namur, 1171-94, b. 1150; d. Nov. 8, 1194; m. Marguerite I of Flanders, d. Nov. 15, 1194, dau. of Theodore, Count of Flanders and Sibyl of Anjou, dau. of Fulk V, Count of Anjou,

ISABELLA OF HAINAUT, b. ca. 1170; d. Mar. 15, 1190; m. Apr. 28, 1180, (his first) Philip II, Augustus, King of France, 1180-1223, Crusader, b. Aug. 21, 1165; d. at Nantes, July 14, 1223, son of Louis VII, the Young, King of France and Alix (or Adela) of Champagne (his third) dau. of Theobald II, Count of Champagne,

LOUIS VIII, the Lion, King of France, 1223-26, b. Sept. 5, 1187; d. at Montpensier, Auvergne, Nov. 8, 1226; m. May 23, 1200, Blanche of Castile, b. 1188; d. 1252, dau. of Alfonso VIII, the Good, King of Castile and Eleanor of England, dau. of Henry II, King of England,

LOUIS IX, the Saint, King of France, 1226-70, Crusader, b. at Poissy, Apr. 25, 1214; d. nr. Tunis, Aug. 25, 1270; m. at St. Etienne, Sens, May 27, 1234, Marguerite of Provence, b. 1221(?); d. 1295, dau. of Raymond IV Berenger, Count of Provence and Beatrice of Savoy, dau. of Thomas, Count of Savoy,

PHILIP III, the Bold, King of France, 1270-85; b. 1245, d. at Perpignan, Oct. 5, 1285; m. (first) at Clermont, May 28, 1262, Isabella of Aragon, b. 1247; d. Jan. 28, 1271, dau. of James I, King of Aragon and Yolande of Hungary, dau. of Andreas II, King of Hungary,

PHILIP IV, the Fair, King of France, 1285-1314, b. at Fountainbleau, 1268; d. Nov. 29, 1314; m. Aug. 16, 1284, Jeanne I, of Navarre, Queen of Navarre, b. 1272; d. 1305, dau. of Henry I, King of Navarre and Blanche of Artois, dau. of Robert I, Count of Artois,

ISABELLA OF FRANCE, b. 1292; d. Aug. 22, 1358; m. at Boulogne, Jan. 25, 1307/8, Edward II, King of England, b. at Carnarvon, Apr. 28, 1284; d. at Berkeley Castle, Sept. 21, 1327, son of Edward I, King of England and Eleanor of Castile, dau. of Ferdinand III, King of Castile and Leon,

EDWARD III, of Windsor, King of England, 1327-77; b. at Windsor, Nov. 13, 1312; d. at Shene, June 21, 1377; m. Jan. 24, 1328/9, Philippa of Hainaut, b. ca. 1314; d. at Windsor Castle, Aug. 14, 1369, dau. of William III, Count of Hainaut & Holland and Jeanne of Valois, dau. of Charles, Comte de Valois,

LADY JOAN BEAUFORT, b. at Beaufort Castle; d. at Howden, co. York, Nov. 13, 1440; m. (second) ante Nov. 29, 1396, Ralph Neville, K.G., 1st Earl of Westmoreland, b. 1364; d. at Raby, Oct. 21, 1425, son of John de Neville, K.G., 3rd Lord Neville of Raby and his first wife, Maud de Percy, dau. of Henry Percy, 2nd Lord Percy,

LADY CICELY NEVILLE, b. at Raby Castle, Durham, May 3, 1415; d. at Berkhamstead Castle, May 31, 1495; m. ante Oct. 18, 1424, Richard Plantagenet, K.G., Duke of York, b. Sept. 21, 1411; d. at Wakefield, Dec. 30, 1460, son of Richard, Earl of Cambridge and Lady Anne Mortimer (his first), dau. of Roger Mortimer, Earl of March (heir presumptive to Richard II),

EDWARD IV, King of England, 1461-70/1471-83, b. at Rouen, Apr. 28, 1442; d. at Westminster Palace, Apr. 9, 1483; m. at Grafton, Northants, May 1, 1464, Lady Elizabeth Woodville, b. at Grafton Regis, ca. 1437; d. at Bermondsey Abbey, June 7, 1492, wid. of Sir John Grey and dau. of Richard Woodville, 1st Earl Rivers and Jacquetta of Luxemburg, dau. of Pierre I of Luxemburg,

PRINCESS MARY TUDOR, b. Richmond Palace, Mar. 18, 1496; d. at Westhorpe Hall, Suffolk, June 26, 1533, wid. of Louis XII, King of France; m. at Hotel Cluny, Paris, (second) aft. Feb. 4, 1514/5, Charles Brandon, 1st Duke of Suffolk, b. ca. 1484; d. at Guilford Palace, Aug. 22, 1545, son of Sir William Brandon and Elizabeth Bruyn,
